WHEREAS the Settlor is desirous of establishing a charitable Trust to be known as "**SUSILA BATAKRUSHNA CHARITABLE TRUST**" and in short "**SBC TRUST**" for the objects stated herein after; AND

WHEREAS it is intended that the Trustees shall use the Trust Funds for the purpose herein after mentioned.

1. Definitions:- In this deed unless the context otherwise require;

- (a) "Trust purpose", shall mean the objects set out under clause 6 of this deed.
- (b) "Permanent Trustee" shall mean a permanent trustee appointed by the Settlor at the time of formation of the trust named herein after and shall include a person nominated by a permanent trustee so appointed, in his place on resignation, retirement or death but the number of permanent trustees shall not exceed 5(five) at any point of time.

8. Investment of corpus of trust fund- Subject to clause 7(g), the Trustees may invest any monies forming the whole or part of the corpus of the Trust Fund from time to time, in any securities authorised by the Indian Trust Act, 1882 or in such other shares or securities as the Trustees may in their discretion think fit without being liable for loss.

9. Meeting of the Trust: The Trust shall hold at least 2 meetings in a year. The managing Trustee shall convene such meeting as and when required.

10. Requisition Meeting of Trustees:- The Trustees shall hold meetings at such intervals as they may decide in case of exigency by placing a requisition for such meeting with the Chairman and the Chairman shall take steps to convene such meeting. The quorum at each such meeting shall be at least three permanent trustees personally present in that meeting. Decisions thereat shall be taken by majority of votes unless otherwise provided herein. The Chairman shall preside at all the meetings and shall in case of equality of votes, have a casting vote. Any other Permanent Trustee, with approval of the Chairman, shall preside at the meetings if the Chairman is absent or unable to attend.

11. Powers and duties of the Managing Trustee:- The Managing Trustee shall attend to the day-to-day affairs of the Trust and shall exercise such powers and perform such duties as the Trustees may vest in him from time to time. The Managing Trustee is hereby specifically authorised to open and operate either singly

or jointly with any other Permanent Trustee, any type of account with any of the Scheduled Banks in India as per decision of the Trustees.

12. Decisions by circulation:- The Trustees may take decisions by circulation of Trust matters to be approved by a majority of Trustees, after the matters have been circulated to all the Trustees, then in India.

13. Reimbursement of expenses and remuneration:- The Trustees shall be entitled to receive and be paid out of the Trust Fund, all out of pocket including travelling and other expenses reasonable and legitimately incurred by them in connection with Trust matters and incurred for attending any meetings of the Trustees or any committee thereof. Save as aforesaid, the Trustees including the Chairman shall not be entitled to any remuneration for serving as such; provided that the Trustees may employ any of the Trustees being engaged in any profession or business, or in a firm of which he shall be a member, to do any act or transact any business (whether or not an act or business which only a person engaged in that profession or business can do) and may such charges for the act or business done by him or his firm as aforesaid as he or they might make or recover if the Trustee or whose firm may be so employed was not a Trustee.

14. Retirement, etc. of trustees:-

(a) Any Trustee may retire on giving three months notice in writing thereof to the others.

(b) A Trustee shall automatically cease to be and shall vacate the office of the Trustee on the happening of any of the following:

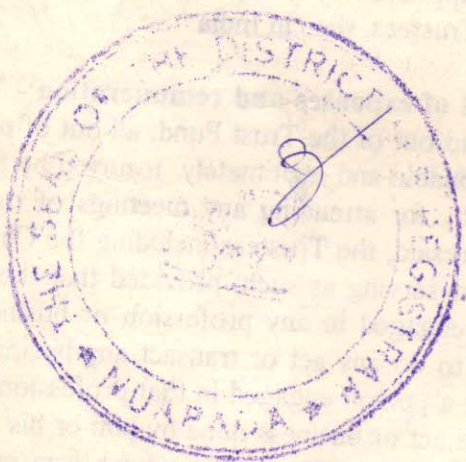

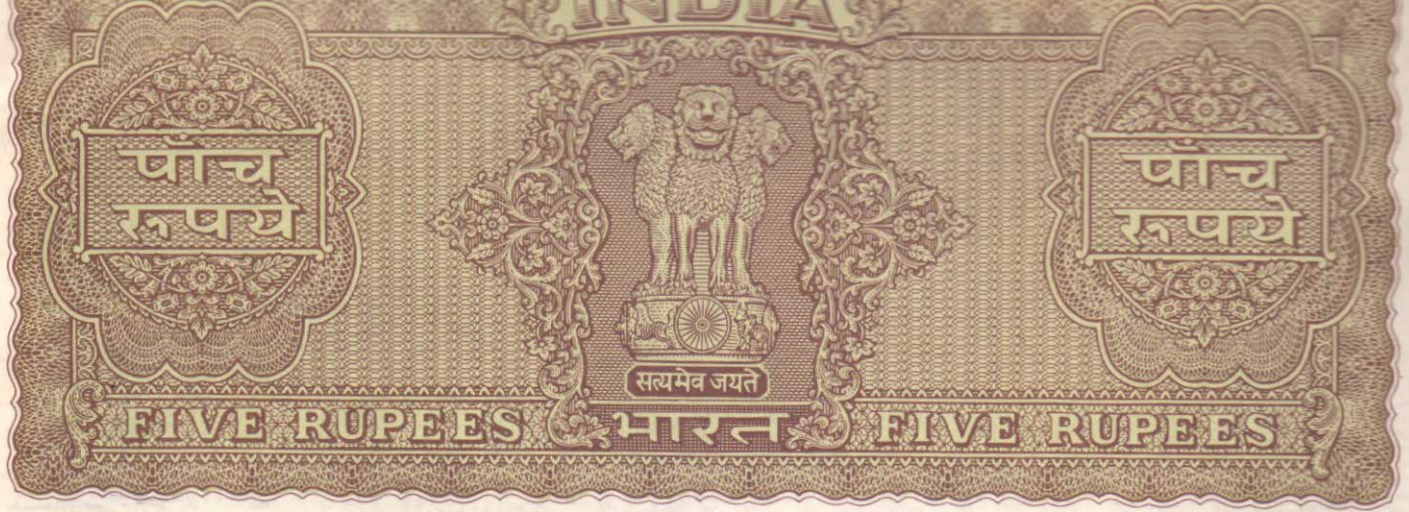

appointed by the Trustees. The financial year shall comprise of twelve months, except the year of inception which may comprise of a period more/less than twelve months.

17. Rules and Regulation:- for the proper conduct of the affairs of the Trust, the Trustees shall have the power to frame and implement Rules and Regulation s which shall be consistent with the presents herein provided.

18. Dissolution:- If the Trustees shall be unanimously of the opinion that the Trust be dissolved, such dissolution shall be effected by an instrument in writing under their hands and if, after all the debts and liabilities of the Trust have been paid or provided for, there shall remain any assets, the same shall be transferred to some other organization or association having aims or objects which in the unanimous opinion of the Trustees are similar to all or any of the Trust purposes.
